KEY FACTS

- Partner university: Warsaw School of Economics (SGH)
- Structure:
 - 1st year: JGU Mainz (program's language English)
 - 2nd year: SGH Warsaw (program's language English)
- No Polish language skills required
- Master Thesis can be written either in Mainz or in Warsaw
- While seeking the MIEPP degree in Mainz, participating students might choose between a degree in "Management" or in "Finance and Accounting" at SGH
- Each winter semester, five students are admitted to enroll in the 2-year Double Degree Program

What is ERASMUS+?

The European Union's ERASMUS+ program is a student exchange program that enables you to spend part of your studies abroad at one of many participating European partner universities.

- ✓ About **30** partner universities in **13** different countries
- ✓ Optionally **1 or 2 semesters** abroad (Start in Winter term)
- ✓ Student grant for Erasmus students
- ✓ Remittal of tuition fees at the partner university
- ✓ **Administrative support** and supervision during the whole process from the application procedure until returning to Mainz



Application Process

Procedure

Application deadline end of November 2024

To Do's:

1. Online-Application

- Personal Data
- Priorities (max. 3)

2. Written Application as a PDF via E-Mail

- Acceptance / rejection usually before Christmas
- Second round for remaining places in January

Written Application

- Letter of motivation
- CV
- Transcript of Records
- High school diploma
- Other relevant documents, e.g. internship certificates, proof of voluntary activities
- In English or German





Notice for students in Germany with Visa

- ✓ If you are in Germany with a VISA, **you can also participate** in the ERASMUS program
- However, please be aware of the fact that your residence permit in another EU country may be limited to 3 months without losing the residence permit in Germany
- Yet, **it is possible to extend your stay** in a foreign EU country without losing residence permit in Germany you will need to talk individually to the German administrative offices
- Thus, a detailed planning far in advance is necessary







After logging in, select **Studies** in the top menu bar, then click on **Examinations** on the left and then on **Exam Registration**:

Entering the TAN

You must then confirm the registration by entering a transaction number (TAN). To do so, type in an unused TAN from your current TAN list in the lower part of the screen and click the Submit button on the right. Then cross out the TAN that you have used from your TAN list, as it is now invalid. For more information on the TAN procedure, please refer to **TAN procedure** section:



- A module's exam may consist of:
 - one exam for all courses of a module ("Module final-exams") or of
 - separate exams for each of the courses of a module ("Module part-exams")
 - → part-exams of a module can be undertaken in different semesters.
 - E.g. Core Module: Research & Teaching
 - Studies & research in Economics: e-exam
 - Introductory Econometrics: written exam



- **Written exams** (60 − 120 min)
 - Calculations
 - Essay
 - Electronic
 - Multiple choice
- **Oral exams** (15 30 min)
- Semester/term/take-home paper (4 6 weeks)



- Exams can be repeated twice
 (i.e., a total of three attempts: the first attempt+ two retake exams)
- You cannot retake an exam to get a better grade once you succeed
- Failed exams should be retaken as soon as possible but you can also postpone them
- If you are sick during an exam, you will have to provide a doctor's note immediately (rules can be found in the <u>Study Office's download center</u>)







- You must register your thesis by the end of your 6th semester
 (Fachsemester) the latest. Otherwise, the first attempt will be graded with 5.0.
- You can register for your thesis at any time during your studies, provided that you have already successfully completed 60 credit points.
- You have a total of 2 attempts for the Master's thesis.



1st exam attempt: failed, absent without valid excuse

- Self-registration for the retake exam
- Registration for the second round of exams in the same semester is usually possible after the grades have been published up to one week before the retake exam

1st exam attempt: absent with valid excuse, e.g. due to illness

Compulsory registration for the next possible retake by the Study Office



Change of registered modules and courses

If you want to drop an elective module <u>and</u> have already registered for the exam at least once, you can only do this by using a joker. => <u>Joker form</u>

You can use a maximum of two jokers during your studies in the MIEPP.

You can use a joker for an elective module after you have failed the exam for the first, second or third time.
